Field Of Application

The rubber bands are aimed to be used around the Atlantis bagasse products.

Environmental Aspects

Product

The rubber bands are made from natural or synthetic rubber. The do not contain any recycled rubber.

Packaging

Carton is made of renewable material.

The corrugated board box is made from wood, which is a renewable resource.

Product Safety

- The rubber has been tested for Lead (Pb),
 Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent
 chromium (Cr(VI)), Polybrominated biphenyls
 (PBBs), Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDEs)
 and Phthalates such as DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP
 and comply with the limits set by RoHS Directive
 2015/863 amending Annex II to Directive
 2011/65/EU,

Management Of Used Products

Energy Recovery

All the materials are suited for energy recovery. Complete combustion gives mainly rise to carbon dioxide and water. The energy content of plastics/paper is comparable to that of oil/ wood.

Recycling

The rubber bands can be reused several times before thrown with general household waste.

Recycling of the plastic and the corrugated board is possible for producing new products. Check with the local recycling company.
