The raw materials which are used for the napkin s are finished in the ECF bleaching process.

Packaging

Polypropylene & Polypropylene are used for packaging purposes.

The corrugated board box is unbleached and to a large extent made of recycled fibres.

Product Safety

The products / raw material fulfil the following:

- Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27th October 2004 concerning materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.
- LFGB Food, Commodities and Feed Code and Recommendation XXXVI "Papers, cardboard, paperboard intended to come into contact with food.
- The printing inks used are in accordance with the EuPIA Guidelines.
- Duni manufacturing units are certified according to the international quality system ISO 9001 and environmental system ISO 14001 as well as to BRC Consumer Products.

Management Of Used Products

Recycling

The product may be recycled with cardboard and paper materials. Sorting for different waste handling alternatives need to follow local regulations.

Recycling of the plastic and the corrugated board is possible for producing new products. Check with the local recycling company.

Energy Recovery

All the materials are suited for energy recovery. Complete combustion gives mainly rise to carbon dioxide and water. The energy content of plastics/paper is comparable to that of oil/ wood.
