Field of Application

Unprinted, printed and/or dyed napkins (incl. Elegance), tablecloths, tablecloth rolls, table runners, slipcover, placemats and bibs.

All products described in this document can safely come into contact with all kinds of food. However, due to the nature of fiber materials, it is not recommended to use the products made from this material to keep very moist food since material strength will be lost.

The material should not be used for heating food in a microwave oven.

Duni declares that the article meets the requirements of:
