### Area of Use

The cups are suitable for all aqueous, acidic, and alcoholic beverages, both hot and cold, under hot-fill conditions of up to 100 °C. As the cups do not have plastic lamination, their stability may decrease if they are used or left filled for several hours. Prolonged use may also lead to leakage, particularly when the cups are used with beverages containing a high alcohol content (>20%).

The cups should not be used for reheating beverages in a microwave as this may compromise their stability, increasing the risk of burns.

### Test conditions

Migration tests on the material of the article performed by an independent institute shows t the tested sample meets the requirements of the German LFGB and Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004.

PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are not intentionally being used in any step of manufacturing the cups.
